Public Information & Openness Statement

1. Purpose and Scope

This statement implements ISO/IEC 17029:2019 Clause 4.3.4 (Openness — a verification body needs to provide public access to, or disclosure of, appropriate information about its verification process), Clause 5.3.6 (the publicly available commitment to impartiality), and Clause 10.1 (Publicly available information). It applies to EnviroSense's verification activities as a whole and is intended for an external audience: clients, prospective clients, accreditation assessors, and any other interested party.

2. Our Validation/Verification Process

EnviroSense Futures Limited provides third-party verification (and, where within our current scope of accreditation, validation) services against ISO 14064-1:2018 GHG statements and related claims. Our process runs from initial enquiry and engagement acceptance, through planning, risk assessment, site selection, evidence-gathering and sampling, to independent review, decision and issue of a verification statement, and (where relevant) post-issuance handling of facts discovered after issue. This process is governed by our controlled Operational Procedures (OP-001 through OP-005) and is consistent with ISO/IEC 17029:2019 and ISO 14064-3:2019.

3. Our Commitment to Impartiality

EnviroSense Futures Limited understands the importance of impartiality in carrying out verification activities. We manage conflicts of interest, safeguard objectivity, and do not allow commercial, financial or other pressures to compromise our impartiality. Threats to impartiality are identified, assessed and, where necessary, eliminated or minimised through our Impartiality Procedure (OP-008) and our Impartiality & Independence Policy (D.DMS-007), which are overseen with the involvement of our Impartiality Committee.
